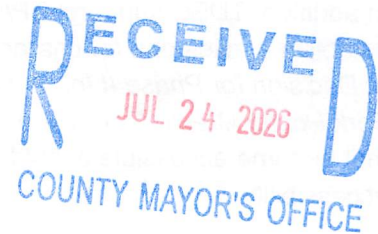

RE: Transmittal of the Addendum to the Removal Action Work Plan for the Y-12 Facilities Deactivation /Demolition Project, Oak Ridge, Tennessee A19/R1 Demolition of Facility 9720-17, Warehouse/Industrial (DOE/OR/01-2479&D1/A19/R1)

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Land Protection-Remediation Branch, Oak Ridge Office, received the above referenced submittal on June 22, 2026. The document has been reviewed pursuant to the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) for the Oak Ridge Reservation. While the review did not identify any new comments, some of the responses to TDEC comments require additional clarification. These clarifications are minor and could have easily been resolved had the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) conducted a comment resolution meeting prior to submittal of the revised document. As discussed and agreed to by the FFA parties, comment resolution meetings are a crucial step in ensuring comments are resolved and significant issues are identified. Since DOE elected to move forward with submitting the document without conducting a comment resolution meeting, the following clarifications should be noted:

- **TDEC Comment #1**
Section 4.4 should have included a figure that shows where the site-specific environmental controls and best management practices will be placed. This information should be provided to TDEC and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) prior to the start of demolition.
- **TDEC Comment #2**
DOE should ensure the EMWMF waste lot profile is revised to identify the 9744 dust collection mechanical system as anomalous.
- **TDEC Comment #3**
Slabs remaining following demolition should be managed in accordance with the *Addendum for the Removal Action Work Plan for the Y-12 Facilities Deactivation/Demolition Project Oak Ridge, Tennessee: Provisional Management of Slabs (DOE/OR/01-2479&D1/A16/R1)*.

- **TDEC Comment #9**

Continued post-demolition monitoring may be necessary if the two post-demolition sampling results identify elevated contaminant levels or other concerns.

In addition, TDEC supports EPA's request (letter from Jason Poe dated July 10, 2026) for DOE to establish a milestone for characterization of the soils beneath 9720-17. In accordance with the *Record of Decision for Phase II Interim Remedial Actions for Contaminated Soils and Scrapyard in Upper East Fork Poplar Creek, Oak Ridge, Tennessee (DOE/OR/01-2229&D3)*, inaccessible soils under buildings that become accessible should be addressed prior to conducting activities that would limit that accessibility.
